In these highly uncertain and rapidly changing times, the SADC region, like many other regions in Africa, remains fundamentally dependent on a resilient agricultural system and natural resource base. Climate change still poses the greatest threat to the agricultural system and therefore technical capacity is needed to address these future impacts and adapt plans, policies and programs.

Taking into account alternative futures, the SADC Futures project has produced tailored supporting materials and documents as part of a wider approach for foresight training in the region. These documents and the associated foresight framework aim to equip users to practically apply the range of foresight tools and methods for innovative strategic planning and policy formulation for climate resilience.

We're organizing a webinar for interested stakeholders to discuss the reports on mega-trends and climate risk assessment, and get some feedback that could be incorporated into the final version.
