On Friday 4 October, the CGIAR Research Program on Climate Change, Agriculture and Food Security (CCAFS), based at the Department of Plant and Environmental Sciences at Copenhagen University, will organise a one-hour science seminar entitled "Managing droughts and floods for improved food security and livelihoods".

The seminar will be led by Vladimir Smakhtin, from the International Water Management

Institute (IWMI), and moderated by CCAFS Director Bruce Campbell. As floods and droughts are only set to increase with climate change, while being major obstacles for sustainable food production and economic development, this seminar will look at issues and potential solutions to extreme water variability providing examples from Africa and Asia.
